

SPIRITUALITY, THE SYSTEM OF SCIENCE AND EDUCATION - A FACTOR OF SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

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Of great importance for the further improvement of the spiritual life of our state is the public center “Spirituality and Enlightenment”, created in 1994 by decision of the president. In order to increase the efficiency, viability and effectiveness of national propaganda and spiritual educational work in our state, by a resolution of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 25, 2006, two centers were created as part of the Republican Council on Spirituality and Education - the Republican Spiritual Educational Center and the National Scientific and Educational Center. The Prime Minister is appointed by the head of the council, and the governors are appointed by the head of the regional councils. The system of spiritual and educational work was improved in accordance with the requirements of the time and conditions. Today, the difficult and threatening situation in the world requires a critical assessment of the work done in the industry and improvement of its activities in accordance with the requirements of the time. In this regard, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M. on July 28, 2017, it was decided to increase the effectiveness of spiritual and educational work and bring the development of the industry to a new level. In accordance with it, by combining the Republican Center for Spiritual and Educational Propaganda and the National Scientific Center for Spirituality and Ideology of the Council of the Republican Center for Spirituality and Enlightenment, the Republican Center for Spirituality and Enlightenment was created. The President of the Republic of Uzbekistan heads the Republican Council for Morality and Education. In December 2016, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M. A period of large-scale accelerated reforms based on Mirziyoyev's strategic development has begun. Thus, new expressions, in particular, concepts such as public communication, public techniques, critical analysis, discipline, the youngest reader, and action strategy. The most important link in cultural and spiritual development is the education system. The reason is that it is impossible to raise society without training personnel who meet the requirements of the time, who have mastered the advanced achievements of science and technology. National education policy in Uzbekistan The Law on Education of the Republic of Uzbekistan, adopted on August 29, 1997 ⁷³ in the new version of the law, as well as in the national training program. The pre-school education system is the main element of the initial level of continuing education. Pre-school education up to 6-7 years is provided in the family,

kindergarten and other educational institutions. According to the scientific conclusion of experts, 70% of the information and knowledge that a person receives during his life, he receives at the age of 5 years. Because of this, it is very important that children grow up healthy and educated, with mature talented staff. In order to further improve the preschool education system, strengthen the material and technical base, expand the network of preschool institutions, and provide qualified teaching staff, President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M. Mirziyoyev signed a decree On improving the management of the preschool education system on September 30, 2017⁷⁴. The Ministry of Pre-School Education was established. Reforms in the education system, 2017 was the year of major reforms in the system of general and special vocational education. The suggestions and feedback received by the public reception rooms and the virtual reception of the president are based on the results of a survey conducted among parents of graduates of republican schools. At Mirziyoyev's initiative, 9+3, that is, from 12 years of compulsory education, were transferred to 11 years of study. - in accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated February 7, 2017 On the Strategy of Actions for the further Development of the Republic of Uzbekistan, through the development of a program for improving the higher education system for 2017-2021, further modernization of educational programs, expanding the powers of higher education institutions in the search for additional sources of financing and the provision of paid services, their independence is developing in stages. The Action Strategy identifies priority tasks for the development of the activities and effectiveness of higher education institutions in accordance with international standards for assessing the quality of education and education. With this in mind, President Sh.M.Mirziyoyev said that we will make every effort and opportunity of our state and society so that young people with independent thinking, high intellectual and spiritual potential can grow up and become happy people who do not face their peers in any field around the world. After a break of more than 10 years in 2017, taking into account the needs for qualified personnel in the state and society, the President of Uzbekistan Sh.M. At the initiative of Mirziyoyev, the system of correspondence education was restored, and special correspondence education was improved. On November 16, 2017, a decree was adopted by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan On improving the regime for conducting entrance examinations to the bachelor's degree of higher educational institutions of the republic. According to it, in the 2018-2019 academic year, there will be no testing in educational areas in the fields of culture, art, design, fine arts, music education, art, sports and physical education, where abilities other than abilities are required. For example, in order to expand the opportunities to increase the intellectual potential of young people in educational activities requiring distinctive abilities, the Uzbek State Conservatory, the Uzbek State Institute of Arts and Culture, the Komillitdin Behzod National Institute of Art and Design,

the Uzbek State Institute of Physical Culture and International Practice of Foreign States, Il liqor on January 1, 2017-postgraduate education were introduced two systems. The first is the basic doctoral program, which provides for the assignment of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) for the defense of a dissertation and the relevant branch of science, and the second is a doctoral program, which provides for the assignment of the degree of Doctor of Science (Doctor of Science) for the defense of a dissertation and the relevant branch of science. No matter which state or nation has the opportunity to improve and implement the achievements of science and technology, its future will be great if it is brought to the level of public policy. Educating highly spiritual youth with modern knowledge and professions, independent opinion in the spirit of national and universal values is one of the most important tasks for us. Considering that more than half of the population of our state is young people, we will briefly touch upon the tasks related to strengthening ideological immunity in the hearts and minds of our children, protecting our youth from various dangers such as drug addiction, religious extremism, and missionary work, which penetrate into the form of "mass culture", their education and upbringing. It is important never to forget that we are responsible. In this regard, we rely on our national traditions that have developed over the centuries, on the rich spiritual heritage of our ancestors⁷⁵.

The years 2016-2017 in the science of Uzbekistan literally became a period of fundamental reforms. On December 30, 2016, President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M. Mirziyoyev met for the first time with leading figures of science of our state. The head of our state Sh.M.Mirziyoyev's decree of February 17, 2017 on measures to improve and stimulate the activities of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan highlighted the need to organize the development of science in Uzbekistan based on the requirements of modern civilization, in particular, the creation of scientific foundations for a strategy for accelerated development of the state and the development of production based on science. The last elections to the full member of the Academy of Sciences were held in 1995. Over the years, the number of academicians has halved, and as of 2017, there are 63 full members of the Academy. By the historic decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated December 29, 2017 On the approval of full members of the Academy of Sciences of the Republic of Uzbekistan, 32 new full members of the Academy of Sciences were approved after a 22-year break. To date, 400 organizations engaged in scientific research have been registered, 36 thousand specialists in the field of science have been employed, in particular, more than 2 thousand doctors of sciences and more than 9 thousand candidates of sciences. Meanwhile, the analysis of the development path won by our state, today, when demand in the world market is sharply increasing and competition is growing in the context of globalization, required the development of a common new approach to the development of our state at a faster pace. The President Of

Our State Is Sh.M. In order to further increase the effectiveness of the reforms initiated by Mirziyoyev, create conditions for sustainable, dynamic development of the state and society, implement priority areas for the modernization of our state and liberalize the sphere of life, the decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated February 7, 2017 for 2017-2021 confirmed the action strategy for five priority areas of development of the Kyrgyz Republic. The action strategy contains 5 priority areas for further development of the state : Improvement of the system of state and public construction (blue is a symbol of air, sky and clean waters, the color of the flag of the state of Amr Timur). II. Ensuring the rule of law and further reform of the judicial and legal system (purple is a symbol of the rule of law and nobility). III. Economic development and liberalization (gold is a symbol of power and wealth, which are considered elements of economic development). IV. The development of the social sphere (the red color is a symbol of life and ensuring a decent way of life for the people). Security, religious tolerance and interethnic exchange, interracial interests and foreign policy (white is a symbol of peace and purity, which are considered elements of a peaceful policy). The strategy was developed based on the results of studying relevant and exciting issues for people and entrepreneurs, analyzing legislation, law enforcement practice and foreign experience. The action strategy is implemented in 5 stages, each of which provides for the approval of a separate annual state program based on the term year. To implement the action strategy, a National Commission of 14 people, headed by the President, was established, which determined the timely and high-quality fulfillment of the tasks set out in this document. The Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On State policy towards youth" of 2016 was adopted⁷⁶. The adoption of the law "On State Policy towards Youth" will serve to strengthen the rights and legitimate interests of youth in our state, strengthen the responsibility of state organizations and other organizations in the implementation of state policy towards youth, further enhance the effectiveness of measures aimed at educating a healthy, harmonious generation in this area. In accordance with the decree of the President of Uzbekistan "on improving the effectiveness of state policy towards youth and supporting the activities of the Youth Agency of Uzbekistan" dated July 2017, military academic lyceums in our state were given the name "Temurbekov School". To further stimulate the youth, the Valor Award was established. In September 2017, in order to assist students in achieving high results in the exact sciences, identify their abilities in the field of information and communication technologies and create the necessary conditions for the realization of their abilities in the field of information and communication technologies, the Ministry of Information Technology and Communications of the Republic of Uzbekistan decided to establish the Okitish specialized school (Al-Khorezmi school) has been installed. "Today's global youth is the largest generation in terms of numbers in the entire history of mankind, because they amount to 2 billion people. Tomorrow, the well-being of our planet depends on how perfect our children are. In this regard, Uzbekistan proposes to develop a
